

## Minutes of Burgh and Tuttington Parish Council Meeting held in Burgh Reading Room at 7.30pm on 07/03/2016

---

Present: Mr David Papworth ( Chairman), Mrs Rosemary Topping ( Vice-Chairman), Mrs Judith Holloway, Mr Colin Piggott, Mr Frank Hurrell, Mr Richard Llewellyn.

1. The Chairman welcomed all to the meeting; there were three residents present. In addition Mrs Andra Papworth was asked to temporarily become minute Secretary.
2. Apologies were received from Mrs Caryl Taylor. In addition the Parish Council clerk was unable to be present and offered his apologies.
3. The minutes of the meeting of 7<sup>th</sup>. December 2015 had been circulated and were approved by the meeting.
4. Matters arising:
  - a. The Tutt cottage drain had not been attended to.
  - b. The highways authority had declined to erect finger posts outside Tuttington Church,
  - c. The Chairman had arranged a meeting to take place on 17<sup>th</sup>. March with all concerned to discuss high water levels at Burgh Mill
  - d. The Chairman reported the correspondence he had received from NCC concerning the traffic to the proposed Anaerobic Digester at Aylsham.
5. Correspondence: A letter from Broadland DC re: the lease of land on Wood Lane. Councillors decided to request a continuance of the lease to the Parish Council which would then be let to Mr Grix.
6. There were no planning matters
7. The clerk had arranged for distribution of the financial report which illustrated a credit balance of £2399.08 ( Which included £422 from village fund raising and money reserved for community projects )
